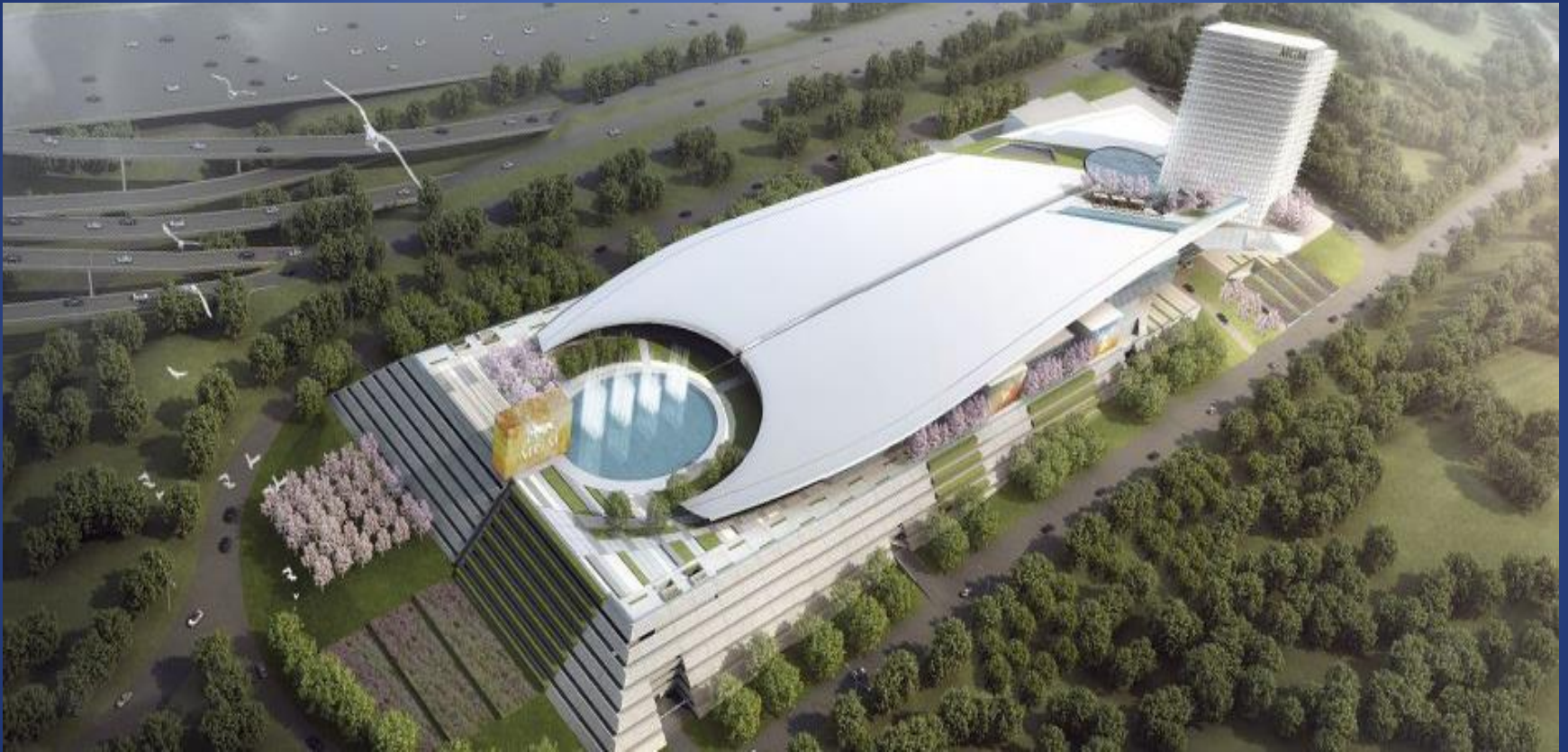

Ingress Traffic Flow

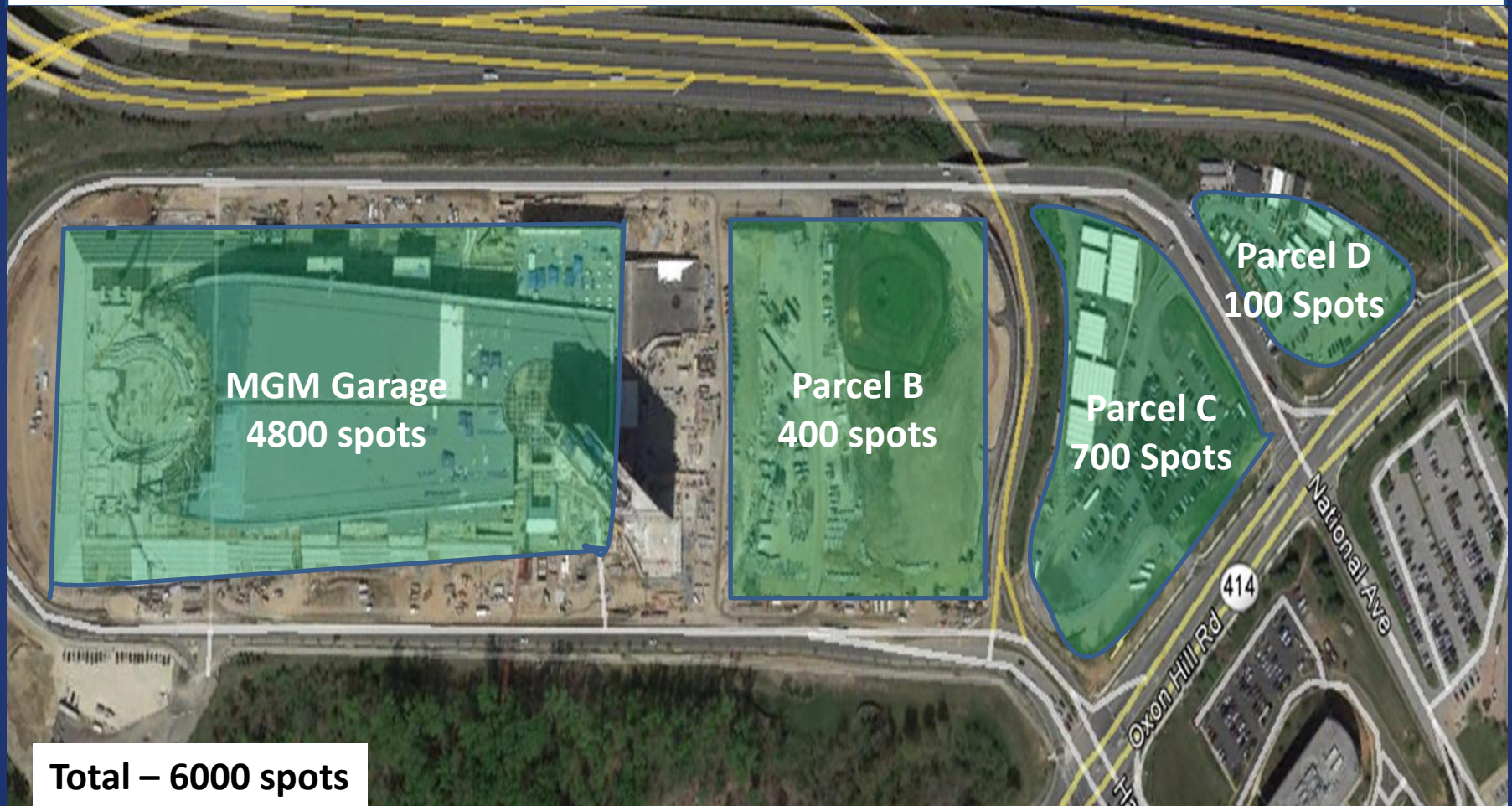


