The application shall be made each year before April 1 after the date of finality; shall be made under oath; shall contain a legal description of the real property upon which the tobacco barn is located; and shall contain such information as will enable the Director of Finance to determine whether the applicant can qualify for the tax credit.

(d) In the event the Director of Finance determines that the application does not qualify for the tax credit, the reason for the denial shall be communicated to the applicant. SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
