SUBJECT: Commercial Inspection Procedure (CIP)

PURPOSE: To provide information relative to a new revised Commercial Inspection Procedure

AUTHORITY: This bulletin is issued by authority granted to the Building Code Official as detailed in Subtitle 4, Prince George's County Building Code.

Effective March 12, 2001, Prince George's County will implement a revised Commercial Inspection Procedure. Permits issued after March 12, 2001 will be required to have certifications of compliance with the Maryland Accessibility Code.

## Under the new Commercial Inspection Procedure

- The Structural Engineer of Record and/or Architect of Record is required to provide certification regarding the projects compliance with the Maryland Accessibility Code and the accessibility requirements of the Prince George's County Building Code. This is to include all <u>building</u> and <u>site</u> accessibility issues as required in the referenced Codes.
- The revised "Standard Certification Document, Revision #1" (2/7/01) is attached.

Any comments concerning this bulletin should be forwarded to the Chief Building Code Official within 30 calendar days from the date of this bulletin.
