The official is prohibited from entering a paid contract or receiving compensation to advocate to the Director of the Prince George's County Department of Parks of Recreation and the Chairman of the Prince George's County Planning Board on the Artworks Now Project, which is a matter that is the subject of legislative action, until the conclusion of one calendar year from the date he/she left County office. However, official can revisit this issue once official has been out-of-office one calendar year from the date official separated from the County |
