### EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 13 – 2022

**WHEREAS**, Section 410 of the Prince George's County Charter authorizes the County Executive to designate in writing the Chief Administrative Officer or some other person in the executive branch to perform the duties of the County Executive during the latter's temporary inability to perform such duties by reason of absence from the County or disability; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive will be absent from the County beginning November 11, 2022, through November 21, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 25-2020, dated December 10, 2020, designated the Chief Administrative Officer, Tara H. Jackson, as Acting County Executive in the event of the County Executive's disability or absence from the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Administrative Officer will also be absent from the County beginning November 11, 2022; now, therefore

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Barry L. Stanton, Deputy Chief Administrative Officer for Public Safety and Homeland Security, is hereby designated to serve as Acting County Executive beginning November 11, 2022, through 12:01 a.m., November 18, 2022; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Executive Order No. 25-2020, which designates the Chief Administrative Officer as Acting County Executive shall again be in effect 12:01 a.m., November 18, 2022, through November 21, 2022, and during future occasion(s) that the County Executive's disability or absence from the County prevents the County Executive from being able to perform her duties; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that a copy of this Executive Order shall be filed with the Clerk of the Council; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, that except as otherwise stated herein, that this Order rescinds and supersedes any prior Order issued pursuant to Section 410 of the Prince George's County Charter.
