
SECTION STAIR




## AREAWAY STAIR - LONGITUDINAL SECTION

SCALE: 3/8"=1'-0"

## Notes:

- 1.) the areaway stair landing shall be at least four inches below the interior floor slab and sloped to drain to an approved general purposed area drain.
- outfall of four inches.
- accessibility for maintenance of drain body and pipe.
- minimum fall of 1/8-inch per foot piped to sump pump crock or a day-lighted outfall at grade.
- exterior foundation drain or drain tile.
- 6.) the pipe shall be sleeved where it passes through the foundation wall or frost protected footing.
- 7.) the general purpose drain assembly and rigid pipe may be constructed of schedule 40 pvc, cast iron or equivalent approve rigid pipe.
- 8.) riser and tread sizes that are shown are suggested for exterior use; however, Prince George's County code amendments, Subtitle 4, allow a maximum riser height of 81/4" and a minimum tread depth of 9" for one and two family dwellings.
