After removing all of the ballots in the batch, the ballot envelopes are set aside. Each canvassing team reviews the ballots for compliance and tabulating acceptability.

Web delivered ballots are duplicated by a bi-partisan ballot duplication team and verified for accuracy.

Ballots that are untimely or otherwise not in compliance were placed in a folder/envelope, with the canvassing team's number, or other information identifying the canvassing team to which the ballot belongs, and the reason(s) for the referral written on the envelope. The envelope with the ballots inside is referred to the Board of Canvassers for later review.

Those timely ballots that are in compliance and could be read by the ballot scanner are referred to the Board of Canvassers for acceptance.
