HOUSING & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FORUM

Prince George's County is developing their 2026-2030 Consolidated Plan and 2026 Annual Action Plan along with the joint Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice with the City of Bowie. These documents are required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and include market analysis, community input, and policy analysis to identify housing and community development needs as well as barriers and impediments that restrict a person's housing choice. The study includes topics such as:

- Community development and housing needs;
- Service needs for special populations;
- Racial and ethnic segregation, including segregated, concentrated areas of poverty;
- Gentrification and displacement of residents from their communities;
- Access to communities with high quality schools, good jobs, and public transportation;
- Access barriers for people with disabilities;
- Zoning regulations that limit housing types and price points;
- Fair housing enforcement; and
- Particular housing challenges faced by families with children, voucher holders, and persons with disabilities.
