Dear County Executive Alsobrooks:

The Prince George's County Council on May 14, 2019 reviewed your recommendations for the FY 2020-2022 Local Impact Grant (LIG) Multiyear Spending Plan, contained in your April 12, 2019 letter, as required by State and County law. We understand that this draft FY 2020-2022 Spending Plan will be forwarded to the Local Development Council, pursuant to Section 10-309.02 of the County Code, for review after these comments are received from the County Council.

The Council would recommend that the Local Development Council consider the reallocation of \$535,800 mandated for the public safety category into the health and human services category to expand grants to organizations within the service area. We would also recommend keeping the District 7 police station and fire stations in immediate proximity to the gaming facility fully staffed.

The County Council appreciates your consideration of these recommendations. We look forward to continued engagement with you about the most impactful uses of LIG funding from the Prince George's County gaming facility.
